Living Arts Long Beach connects you to professional, experienced artists who have careers in the arts. From these artists, you will gain insight and exposure to various art careers that may allow you greater clarity in helping you define your career interests. Guest artists will share their personal journey in their career, advise on ways to grow in their industry, and teach a tangible art skill to get you thinking and performing like a professional.

Guest artist include:

Visual artists, poets, performers, musicians, silkscreen artist, T-shirt designer, animation and many more! (Note. These are some artists we had in the past. Artists are subject to change without notice due to availability)

Living Arts Long Beach meets 2 times per month for six months that includes 12 art workshops, field trip and studio visits. At each workshop a guest artist will present their career path, their specific industry and lead a creative art project. Throughout the program participants will learn various art skills from writing to designing a T-Shirt. At the end of the program, participants will showcase or do a performance at a year-end-presentation, taking place in April/May 2019.

Qualifications:

- Age 14-24, high school and young adults that have high interest in art or hoping to pursue art as a career

Commitments:

- 6 months, meeting 2 times per month from estimated time is November 2019 to May 2020
- 12 workshops, 2 times per month on Wednesdays from 3:30PM to 6:00PM at UCC office
- Showcase exhibitions in May 2020
